

## Music for Overchurch Junior School Website

Music is an important part of life at Overchurch Junior School.

Class lessons are mainly delivered through the Charanga Musical School Scheme. It encourages the children to listen and appraise different styles of music. Varied activities include warm-up games, singing, playing instruments, improvisation and composition.

The school provides pupils with plenty of opportunities to enjoy making music through learning to play an instrument individually with specialist teachers - Clarinet, Flute, Keyboard, Violin, Guitar and Brass, and as part of ensembles - Samba Band and Orchestra.

All Year 4 pupils are currently learning to play the violin through the Wider Opportunities Scheme.

There is also an enthusiastic school choir.

Concerts are held at Christmas time and in the Summer term to give children the opportunity to perform to different audiences and the choir also visits residential homes and performs carols at Sainsburys in the lead up to Christmas.
